

High-Quality Instructional Materials Pulse Check Survey of MA Educators

METHODOLOGY

E4E-Massachusetts (E4E-MA) conducted an online, one-question survey of Massachusetts teachers in September 2025 gauging their support for the required use of high-quality instructional materials. 180 educators responded.

FINDINGS

Overwhelmingly, Massachusetts educators believe all teachers should use high-quality, evidence-based instructional materials, indicating likely support for S.338/H.698: An Act Promoting High-Quality Comprehensive Literacy Instruction in All Massachusetts Schools.
